Exhibits: Placed on benches by 8.45 a.m. on Saturday 4th July, 2026. All exhibit birds must remain in cages for the duration of the show. Birds can be collected after 3:30 p.m. unless directed otherwise by Chief Stewart. All competitive cages must be clean, secure and of standard show box quality or similar. No exhibit will be benched without a standard seed-covered floor and a water drinker. To maintain biosecurity and prevent potential contamination, only seed-covered floors will be accepted.

All bird must be healthy and free from illnesses/parasites. Chief Stewart and Judge obtains the right to remove any bird that is deemed of ill health or any exhibit that is not displayed in a suitable, secure and safe cage.

Pet Bird Exhibitors: Open to all ages. Birds must be displayed in a clean and secure cage – does not need to be show caged standard. Birds must be healthy and free from illnesses/parasites. All exhibit birds must remain in cages for the duration of the show. **This section is independent of the competitive show, and exhibits in this category are only eligible for Grand Champion Pet Bird of Show and The People's Choice Award.**

Exhibitor drop off: Exhibits are to be dropped off at the pavilion. Exhibitors are to safely drive into the showgrounds. Exhibitors are to pay entry fee at the gate.

Judging: From 9am, Saturday 4th July 2026. Exhibitors must not communicate with Judges during the judging process. Judges cannot judge any class in which they have entered. The Judge's decision is final, and exhibitors must refrain from confrontations.

Entry Fee: \$1.00 (including GST) per entry.

Awards: To qualify for Champion of Section awards, each section must have at least three exhibits entered. Sections may be adjusted to merge classes with fewer than three exhibits.

Prize Money: First \$2.00, Second \$1.00. Special awards detailed below.

PLEASE NOTE: Sections and classes can be changed at the discretion of the Chief Stewart and Judges without prior consultation. Changes are subject to entry numbers and the overall flow of the event to ensure fairness and efficiency. Show stewards will try their best to notify exhibitors of class changes upon benching and prior to the commencement of judging.
